

Subordinating Conjunctions

A subordinating conjunction is a word that introduces a dependent clause. Here are some subordinating conjunctions.

after*	now that
although	once
as*	only if
as soon as	since*
because	the first time
by the time	though
even if	unless
even though	until*
every time	when
if	whenever
in case	whereas
in the event that	whether or not
just in case	which
that	while

*These words can also function as prepositions. Be careful, and look at the context of the word before deciding if it is a conjunction or not.
