I show emotion and excitement in a sentence. Many times my sentences end with an exclamation mark.





I replace nouns and pronouns in sentences.



pronoun



The words a, an, and the.

articles





I am a person, place, thing, or idea.

noun





I help describe relationships between other words in a sentence.

preposition





I modify verbs and adjectives and answer the questions to what degree or extent, how, when, and where.







I am a group of words with a subject and verb.

clause





I am a group of words that does not express a complete thought.







We are verbs that attached the main verb and express mood, tense, or voice.

Helping verbs





We connect the subject with a noun or adjective in the predicate.

Linking verbs





The noun or pronoun that is completing the action or state of being in a sentence.







We connect the subject with a noun or adjective in the predicate.

Linking verbs





I want to fly like an eagle to the sea.







Jeremiah was a bullfrog.







My spork thinks he's Batman.



Pronoun, subject, verb pronoun, linking verb, proper noun



Run, run, run, as fast as you can, You can't catch me, <u>I'm the Stinky Cheese Man</u>. (Scieszka)

> Subject, linking verb, article, proper noun





The phone <u>rings</u>, and the girls fight to get <u>there</u> first.

verb, adverb







<u>Oh yeah</u>! I have got something to say! I <u>have</u> <u>been burned</u> by vague lesson <u>plans</u> and a free-floating <u>curriculum</u>! I like my rules, baby, etched in stone, 'cause <u>you</u> know I am going to stick to them!

Interjection, helping verb, object of the preposition (two), pronoun



When wielding the Pitchfork of <u>Power</u>, <u>the</u> Warrior Maid of the North <u>vanquishes</u> <u>all</u> attacking foes.



Object of the preposition, article, verb, adjective





I <u>have climbed</u> the <u>highest</u> mountain; I have run <u>through</u> the fields only to be with <u>you</u>. (Bono)

> Helping verb, adjective, preposition, pronoun





Until his Legos set <u>has reappeared</u>, Arthur will pitch <u>a</u> wall-eyed fit.

Helping verb, article







Mrs. Johnson drinks her hot coffee carefully.

Subject, verb, pronoun, adjective, noun(direct object), adverb





Browsers <u>normally</u> render <u>images</u> that are also hyperlinks. (Musciano and Kennedy 134)

Adverb, noun (direct object)





The background attribute <u>is</u> deprecated in HTML 4 and XHTML <u>because</u> <u>you</u> can achieve similar effects using stylesheets. (Musciano and Kennedy 145) Linking verb, subordinating conjunction, pronoun
