IDENTIFY

I am an action or state of being.

verb



IDENTIFY

I modify nouns and pronouns and answer the questions which one, how many, and what type or kind.

adjective



IDENTIFY

I connect words, phrases, and clauses.



conjunction

IDENTIFY

I show emotion and excitement in a sentence.
Many times my sentences end with an
exclamation mark.

interjection



IDENTIFY

I replace nouns and pronouns in sentences.

pronoun



IDENTIFY

The words a, an, and the.

articles



IDENTIFY

I am a person, place, thing, or idea.

noun



IDENTIFY

I help describe relationships between other words in a sentence.

preposition



IDENTIFY

I modify verbs and adjectives and answer the questions *to what degree or extent*, *how*, *when*, *and* *where*.

adverb



IDENTIFY

I am a group of words with a subject and verb.

clause



IDENTIFY

I am a group of words that does not express a complete thought.

phrase



IDENTIFY

We are verbs that attached the main verb and express mood, tense, or voice.

Helping verbs



IDENTIFY

We connect the subject with a noun or adjective in the predicate.

Linking verbs



IDENTIFY

The noun or pronoun that is completing the action or state of being in a sentence.

subject



IDENTIFY

I am the noun or
pronoun that follows the preposition.

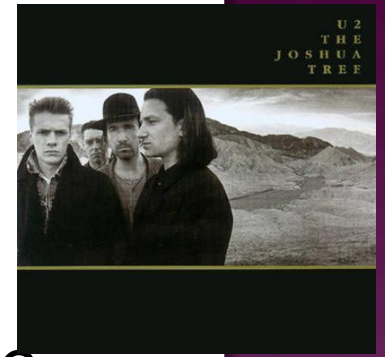
